the gift of childrens' socks and decorate cupcakes at the Birthday party for Jesus, and during Christmas Eve worship, we collected a generous offering of more than \$500 that will be given from Faith Church and Homestead church to help people in need. We are truly working together to serve others in Jesus' name!

Yesterday, we lit the Christ candle again and sang Christmas Carols all through worship! We celebrated the birth of Jesus--Emmanuel--God is with us. Look around you. Pay attention. God has been born into the world! Into this world that we live in! You and I get to decide what to do. God is with us. Are we with God?

Thank you to those who helped with the service and meal celebrating the life of Dave Anderson, who was a regular visitor to Clothed in Faith. Many of the 71 blankets collected in his memory were displayed during the service.

This coming Sunday, January 5th is **Epiphany**—giving Sunday! Epiphany means "the light shines forth" or "the light is made manifest." It's an opportunity for the church to celebrate the Light that shines in the darkness, and a chance to bring our own gifts and to make commitments to God by pledging to serve God with our lives, just as the Wise Ones did so long ago. We'll share Communion together, and when we come to the table, we'll bring our offerings and our pledges for the new year (a pledge letter and pledge sheet is attached to this email, and there will be some available on Sunday).
